

### Exodus 15

<sup>26</sup> He said, "If you listen carefully to the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in his eyes, if you pay attention to his commands and keep all his decrees, I will not bring on you any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians, <u>for I am the LORD</u>, who heals you."

### Psalm 30

<sup>2</sup>O Lord my God, I cried to You and You have healed me.

#### Isaiah 53

<sup>5</sup>But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our guilt and iniquities; the chastisement [needful to obtain] peace and well-being for us was upon Him, and with the stripes [that wounded] Him we are healed and made whole.

#### Jeremiah 17

<sup>14</sup>Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved, for You are my praise.

#### Mark 10

<sup>52</sup>And Jesus said to him, Go your way; your faith has healed you. And at once he received his sight and accompanied Jesus on the road.<sup>(1)</sup>

#### Luke 7

<sup>7</sup>Neither did I consider myself worthy to come to You. But [just] speak a word, and my servant boy will be healed.

#### Luke 18

<sup>42</sup>And Jesus said to him, Receive your sight! Your faith (<sup>[1]</sup> your trust and confidence that spring from your faith in God) has healed you.

#### James 5

<sup>16</sup>Confess to one another therefore your faults (your slips, your false steps, your offenses, your sins) and pray [also] for one another, that you may be healed and restored [to a spiritual tone of mind and heart]. The earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available [dynamic in its working].



# 1 Peter 2

<sup>24</sup>He personally bore our sins in His [own] body on the tree <sup>[1]</sup> [as on an altar and offered Himself on it], that we might die (cease to exist) to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed.

## Psalm 147

<sup>3</sup> He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

## Matthew 4

<sup>23</sup>Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people.

## Proverbs 12

<sup>18</sup> Reckless words pierce like a sword,but the tongue of the wise brings healing.

### Proverbs 15

<sup>4</sup> The tongue that brings healing is a tree of life, but a deceitful tongue crushes the spirit.

### Proverbs 16

<sup>24</sup> Pleasant words are a honeycomb,sweet to the soul and healing to the bones.

### Isaiah 38

<sup>16</sup>O Lord, by these things men live; and in all these is the life of my spirit. O give me back my health and make me live!

### Isaiah 58

<sup>8</sup> Then your light will break forth like the dawn, and your healing will quickly appear; then your righteousness <sup>[1]</sup> will go before you, and the glory of the LORD will be your rear guard.



### Jeremiah 30

<sup>17</sup>For I will restore health to you, and I will heal your wounds, says the Lord, because they have called you an outcast, saying, This is Zion, whom no one seeks after and for whom no one cares!

### Jeremiah 33

<sup>6</sup> " 'Nevertheless, I will bring health and healing to it; I will heal my people and will let them enjoy abundant peace and security.

### Malachi 4

<sup>2</sup> But for you who revere my name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings. And you will go out and leap like calves released from the stall.

#### Matthew 9

<sup>35</sup>Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness.

### Matthew 8

<sup>13</sup>Then to the centurion Jesus said, Go; it shall be done for you as you have believed. And the servant boy was restored to health at that very <sup>[1]</sup> moment.

### Mark 6

<sup>56</sup>And wherever He came into villages or cities or the country, they would lay the sick in the marketplaces and beg Him that they might touch even the fringe of His outer garment, and as many as touched Him were restored to health.

#### Luke 6

<sup>19</sup>and the people all tried to touch him, because power was coming from him and healing them all.



# Psalm 23

A Psalm of David.

<sup>1</sup>THE LORD is my Shepherd [to feed, guide, and shield me], I shall not lack.

<sup>2</sup>He makes me lie down in [fresh, tender] green pastures; He leads me beside the still and restful waters.<sup>(1)</sup>

<sup>3</sup>He refreshes and restores my life (my self); He leads me in the paths of righteousness [uprightness and right standing with Him--not for my earning it, but] for His name's sake. <sup>4</sup>Yes, though I walk through the [deep, sunless] valley of the shadow of death, I will fear or dread no evil, for You are with me; Your rod [to protect] and Your staff [to guide], they comfort me.

<sup>5</sup>You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with <sup>[1]</sup> oil; my [brimming] cup runs over.

<sup>6</sup>Surely or only goodness, mercy, and unfailing love shall follow me all the days of my life, and through the length of my days the house of the Lord [and His presence] shall be my dwelling place.

# Luke 9

<sup>11</sup>but the crowds learned about it and followed him. He welcomed them and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who needed healing.

# Proverbs 14

<sup>30</sup>A calm and undisturbed mind and heart are the life and health of the body, but envy, jealousy, and wrath are like rottenness of the bones.

# Psalm 27

[A Psalm] of David.

<sup>1</sup>THE LORD is my Light and my Salvation--whom shall I fear or dread? The Lord is the Refuge and Stronghold of my life--of whom shall I be afraid?

<sup>2</sup>When the wicked, even my enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.

<sup>3</sup>Though a host encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war arise against me, [even then] in this will I be confident.

<sup>4</sup>One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek, inquire for, and [insistently] require: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord [in His presence] all the days of my life, to behold and gaze upon the beauty [the sweet attractiveness and the delightful loveliness] of the Lord and to



meditate, consider, and inquire in His temple.<sup>(1)</sup>

<sup>5</sup>For in the day of trouble He will hide me in His shelter; in the secret place of His tent will He hide me; He will set me high upon a rock.

<sup>6</sup>And now shall my head be lifted up above my enemies round about me; in His tent I will offer sacrifices and shouting of joy; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the Lord.

<sup>7</sup>Hear, O Lord, when I cry aloud; have mercy and be gracious to me and answer me! <sup>8</sup>You have said, Seek My face [inquire for and require My presence as your vital need]. My heart says to You, Your face (Your presence), Lord, will I seek, inquire for, and require [of necessity and on the authority of Your Word].

<sup>9</sup>Hide not Your face from me; turn not Your servant away in anger, You Who have been my help! Cast me not off, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation!

<sup>10</sup>Although my father and my mother have forsaken me, yet the Lord will take me up [adopt me as His child].<sup>(2)</sup>

<sup>11</sup>Teach me Your way, O Lord, and lead me in a plain and even path because of my enemies [those who lie in wait for me].

<sup>12</sup>Give me not up to the will of my adversaries, for false witnesses have risen up against me; they breathe out cruelty and violence.

<sup>13</sup>[What, what would have become of me] had I not believed that I would see the Lord's goodness in the land of the living!

<sup>14</sup>Wait and hope for and expect the Lord; be brave and of good courage and let your heart be stout and enduring. Yes, wait for and hope for and expect the Lord.

# Psalm 91

<sup>1</sup>HE WHO <sup>[1]</sup> dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall remain stable and fixed under the shadow of the Almighty [Whose power no foe can withstand].

<sup>2</sup>I will say of the Lord, He is my Refuge and my Fortress, my God; on Him I lean and rely, and in Him I [confidently] trust!

<sup>3</sup>For [then] He will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence.

<sup>4</sup>[Then] He will cover you with His pinions, and under His wings shall you trust and find refuge; His truth and His faithfulness are a shield and a buckler.

<sup>5</sup>You shall not be afraid of the terror of the night, nor of the arrow (the evil plots and slanders of the wicked) that flies by day,

<sup>6</sup>Nor of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, nor of the destruction and sudden death that surprise and lay waste at noonday.

<sup>7</sup>A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand, but it shall not come



near you.

<sup>8</sup>Only a spectator shall you be [yourself inaccessible in the secret place of the Most High] as you witness the reward of the wicked.

<sup>9</sup>Because you have made the Lord your refuge, and the Most High your dwelling place,<sup>(1)</sup> <sup>10</sup>There shall no evil befall you, nor any plague or calamity come near your tent.

<sup>11</sup>For He will give His angels [especial] charge over you to accompany and defend and preserve you in all your ways [of obedience and service].

<sup>12</sup>They shall bear you up on their hands, lest you dash your foot against a stone.<sup>(2)</sup> <sup>13</sup>You shall tread upon the lion and adder; the young lion and the serpent shall you trample underfoot.<sup>(3)</sup>

<sup>14</sup>Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore will I deliver him; I will set him on high, because he knows and understands My name [has a personal knowledge of My mercy, love, and kindness--trusts and relies on Me, knowing I will never forsake him, no, never].

<sup>15</sup>He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him.

<sup>16</sup>With long life will I satisfy him and show him My salvation.

# Psalm 103

[A Psalm] of David.

<sup>1</sup>BLESS (AFFECTIONATELY, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul; and all that is [deepest] within me, bless His holy name!

<sup>2</sup>Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul, and forget not [one of] all His benefits--

<sup>3</sup>Who forgives [every one of] all your iniquities, Who heals [each one of] all your diseases, <sup>4</sup>Who redeems your life from the pit and corruption, Who beautifies, dignifies, and crowns you with loving-kindness and tender mercy;

<sup>5</sup>Who satisfies your mouth [your necessity and desire at your personal age and situation] with good so that your youth, renewed, is like the eagle's [strong, overcoming, soaring]!<sup>(1)</sup>

# 2 Timothy 3



<sup>16</sup>Every Scripture is God-breathed (given by His inspiration) and profitable for instruction, for reproof and conviction of sin, for correction of error and discipline in obedience, [and] for training in righteousness (in holy living, in conformity to God's will in thought, purpose, and action),

<sup>17</sup>So that the man of God may be complete and proficient, well fitted and thoroughly equipped for every good work.

# 1 Peter 5

<sup>7</sup>Casting the <sup>[3]</sup> whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, <sup>[4]</sup> once and for all] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you <sup>[5]</sup> watchfully.<sup>[2]</sup>

## Psalm 33

<sup>4</sup>For the word of the Lord is right; and all His work is done in faithfulness.

## Psalm 37

<sup>3</sup>Trust (lean on, rely on, and be confident) in the Lord and do good; so shall you dwell in the land and feed surely on His faithfulness, and truly you shall be fed.

### Psalm 69

<sup>13</sup>But as for me, my prayer is to You, O Lord. At an acceptable and opportune time, O God, in the multitude of Your mercy and the abundance of Your loving-kindness hear me, and in the truth and faithfulness of Your salvation answer me.
